

MGIT Report on the important events organized & achievements of students and faculty during the month of **August, 2016**.

- 1) **Orientation Programme for 1st Years** was conducted by the college on 05.08.2016. Dr. V. Malakonda Reddy, President, CBIT & Advisor, MGIT and Sri D. Kamalakar Reddy, Secretary & Correspondent, CBES have delivered valuable messages to the 1st year students and parents. Dr. G. Chandra Mohan Reddy, Principal of the college in his welcome address, gave a detailed account on the working of MGIT.
- 2) Dr.Kota Bhanu Sankara Rao, Ministry of Steel Chair Professor at MGIT has been constituted as Member of Technology Advisory Board (TAB) in Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited. (MIDHANI).
- 3) The NSS unit of MGIT conducted awareness programme about freedom struggle as a part of Azadi 70 at Khanapur and Kokapet villages on 20.08.2016. About 50 students participated in the above activities. Also conducted Blood donation camp on 23.08.2016 and collected 60 units of blood from students and staff.
- 4) **“70th Independence Day”** was celebrated at MGIT & CBIT with great enthusiasm. Dr. V. Malakonda Reddy, President, CBIT & Advisor, MGIT and Sri D. Kamalakar Reddy, Secretary & Correspondent, Dr. G. Chandra Mohan Reddy, Dr. B. Chennakesava Rao, Principals of MGIT & CBIT, Faculty & Students of both the Institutions participated in the event.
- 5) A One-Day Workshop was held on “Essential Teaching Strategies For Effective Language Learning – A Practical approach to Professional Communication in English through the Text book Fluency in English” Published by Orient Blackswan. Prof. Mohan Raj (Retd), EFLU, Hyderabad is the resource person. The workshop was organized by Dr.C.S. Srinivas, Faculty-in-charge, CGC and Mr.K. Venkata Ramana, Sr. Asst. Prof. of English, Dept. of M & H on 31.08.2016. The workshop was attended by # 150 students of I.B.Tech. and all the faculty of English from Dept. of M&H, MGIT and few faculty of English from the nearby colleges.

- 7) MGIT MUN 2016 was organized from 26th to 28th August 2016 at Luminous One Continent, Abids, Hyderabad. The program attracted students from all over the country. Around 180 delegates participated in the councils. The councils and their agendas were:
 - a) UNGA – Global reduction of military expenditure with emphasis on nuclear disarmament.

 - d) Daily display of Famous Quotations of Indian Freedom Fighters at Foyer plus floral tribute to freedom fighters (one per day).
 - e) The backdrop of MGIT website in tri-colour display (Indian National Flag) throughout the schedule i.e., from 9.8.2016 to 23.8.2016.

- f) On 12/8/2016, A Yoga Session was held to # 240 students of I year ECE-1, ECE-2, ECE-3 and CSE-2. The students learnt and practiced Yoga for a better society celebrating “Indian Freedom Struggle-Yaad Karo Qurbani”.
- g) On 15/8/2016, Flag Hoisting Ceremony was held attended by faculty, staff and students.
- h) On 17/8/2015, (i) Patriotic Songs were sung (ii) “Gandhi”- English Version of the movie was played to the students and (iii) Skits and Character Portrayal of freedom fighters, Plays and Events related to Indian struggle for independence are played.
