Further, the chairman requested all the members to actively participate, express their views and approve the items listed on the agenda.

Agenda Item No.1:

To Confirm the Minutes of the 7th Meeting of the Academic Council held on 13th December, 2024.

Minutes: Prof. G. Chandra Mohan Reddy, the Principal and Chairman of the Academic Council informed that the minutes were circulated to all the members and briefly presented the minutes of the 7th meeting of Academic Council (AC) held on 13th December, 2024 to the esteemed members and the same were confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.2:

Approval of almanac of B.Tech III to VIII semesters (MR22) and M.Tech III and IV semesters (MR22) for the Academic year 2025-26

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 2 regarding the approval of the almanac for the B.Tech III to VIII Semesters (MR22), as well as for the M.Tech III and IV Semesters (MR22) for the academic year 2025-26 was presented and the same is attached as Annexure-I.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.3:

Result Analysis of B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held during December 2024 to March 2025

Minutes : The Chairman presented Item No. 3 regarding the result analysis of the B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held during December 2024 to March 2025 as Annexure II. To improve the results, corrective measures were suggested, including conducting remedial classes after analyzing the performance of students in the first midterm exams. However, irrespective of the quality of student intake, the respective Heads of Departments and faculty members are informed to identify and adopt innovative teaching methods to further enhance the results.

The Chairman thanked and accepted the suggestions given by the members.

Agenda Item No.4:**Approval and Ratification of the Examination notifications and timetables of Semester End Examinations to be from June 2025 to August 2025**

Minutes: The Chairman presented the Item No 4 regarding the ratification of the notifications and timetables of Semester End Examinations to be held from June 2025 to August 2025. He mentioned that the notifications and timetables of Semester End Examinations to be held during June 2025 to August 2025 were scheduled according to the affiliating university JNTUH guidelines and the same is given in Annexure –III.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.5:**Approval for implementation of adding of Grace marks to students of MR-21 Regulations as per JNTUH.**

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 5 regarding the implementation of adding of Grace marks to students of MR-21 Regulations as per Proceedings No. JNTUH/EB/R18 Grace Marks/3/2024, dated 27.04.2024, issued by the Registrar, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH), and the same is attached as Annexure-IV.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.6:**Approval for introduction of value added course being offered to B.Tech VII semester ECE students from Academic year 2025-26.**

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 6 regarding the approval for introduction of value added course on “Real Time Operating System using QNX” for the B. Tech VII Semester ECE students (MR-22). This course will be conducted in collaboration with Pi Square Technologies Pvt. Ltd.', with whom the institution has already signed an MoU.

The course is intended to enhance the practical and industrial readiness of the students by exposing them to real-time operating systems, specifically the QNX Neutrino RTOS, which is widely used in mission-critical and embedded applications across various domains.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed and appreciated by the members.



Agenda Item No. 7:

Review of Campus Placements since 7th Meeting of Academic Council.

Minutes: The Principal presented Item No. 7 regarding campus placements, a total of 259 students from various departments have been placed since last academic council meeting. Since placement process is still ongoing with few companies, the final number of placements will be available by the end of July. The members appreciated the efforts of the Training and Placement Cell of MGIT for securing a significant number of companies for placements, despite the challenges faced.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.8:

Notable Achievements of the Departments since 7th Meeting of Academic Council.

Minutes: The Principal presented the Item No 8 regarding the notable achievements of the Departments since 7th Meeting of Academic Council. The Principal presented significant achievements regarding the award of Ph.Ds, research publications, NPTEL courses, books, patents, book chapters, and the organization of STTPs, FDPs, conferences and other professional activities since the 7th Academic Council meeting. A total of 350 activities across various departments have been presented.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.9:

Approval for introduction of MR-25 Regulations, Curriculum and Syllabus from the Academic Year 2025-26 if JNTUH introduces R25 Regulations, Curriculum and Syllabus.

Minutes: The Principal presented the Item No 9 regarding the BoS meeting to be held from 03th-05th July 2025 at JNTUH to finalize R-25 Regulations, Curriculum and Syllabus from the Academic Year 2025-26. Based on the outcome of the meeting, the chairman requested Academic council member to permit the same as MR-25 Regulations, Curriculum and Syllabus to be adopted at MGIT after conducting the respective BoS meetings to be held in the First week of August 2025, the same may be ratified in the 9th academic council meeting, scheduled in December 2025.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No.10:

To finalize the date for conducting 9th Meeting of Academic Council

Minutes: The Principal tentatively announced that the 9th Academic Council Meeting will be planned in December 2025. The exact date of the meeting will be intimated two weeks before the scheduled date of the meeting.

Agenda item No.11: Any other item with the permission of the chair.

Approval for conducting B.Tech VIII Sem Advanced supplementary exams.

Minutes: The Principal presented the Item No 11 regarding advanced supplementary exams at JNTUH for IV year B.Tech II Semester for final year outgoing students to provide a final opportunity to clear backlogs before graduation. These exams are conducted for students who have failed or absent in the IV year B.Tech II Semester examinations and who have completed their course work and duration as per the academic regulations. The advanced supplementary exams which include theory, practical, and project viva-voce /seminars etc. are conducted immediately after announcing the results of IV year B.Tech II Semester regular examinations.

In this regard, it is proposed to conduct Advanced Supplementary Exams for B.Tech. VIII Semester students at MGIT in line with the advanced supplementary exams conducted by JNTUH.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.
