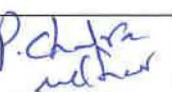

It is proposed to adopt the same criteria for the B.Tech students of MR-22 regulations, unless otherwise JNTUH issues specific guidelines for adding Grace Marks for the B.Tech students of R22 Regulations. If JNTUH issues guidelines for adding Grace marks for the B.Tech students of R22 Regulations, the same will be adopted for B.Tech students of MR-22 Regulations.
