Agenda Item No.3:

Result Analysis of B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held from December 2025 to March 2026

Minutes : The Chairman presented Item No. 3 regarding the Result Analysis of B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held from December 2025 to March 2026.

The members suggested that senior faculty shall be assigned to handle First Year subjects with an objective to strengthen the academic foundation of students and improve overall results. Bridge courses shall be conducted at the beginning of the academic year to address learning

gaps and support students in improving their understanding of fundamental concepts, particularly in Mathematics, CPDS, and other challenging subjects. Departments shall organize tutorial/remedial classes during the semester for difficult subjects to provide additional academic support, improve conceptual clarity, and enhance student performance and pass percentages.

Based on the suggestions of the members, the Chairman informed that the practice is already being followed at MGIT and that it will be implemented more effectively and with greater vigor to support student progress.

The Chairman thanked and accepted the suggestions given by the members.

Approval and Ratification of the Examination notifications and timetables of Semester End Examinations of B.Tech/M.Tech Even semesters of the Academic Year 2025-26

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 7 regarding the approval for enhancement of the revaluation fee as per JNTUH circular, with effect from the Even semester of the Academic Year 2025-26 as per Vide Proceedings No. JNTUH/DUEX/JNTUH/Enhancement of Exam Fees/2025 dated 20.11.2025 issued by the Registrar, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH). The University has enhanced the revaluation fee from Rs. 1000/- to Rs. 3000/-. It is requested to approve the same for implementation to all B.Tech and M.Tech students at MGIT.

Minutes: The Principal presented Item No. 8 regarding campus placements and informed the members that a total of 690 students have been received offers so far. The details of campus placements achieved since the 9th Meeting of the Academic Council were also presented to the members for information and consideration.

The members emphasized the need to improve placements by inviting more core companies for campus recruitment so as to provide better career opportunities to students in their respective disciplines.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

Agenda Item No. 9:

Notable Achievements of the Departments since 9th Meeting of Academic Council.

Minutes: The Chairman presented significant achievements regarding the award of Ph.Ds, research publications, books, patents, book chapters, and the organization of STTPs, FDPs, conferences, Smart India Hackathons, and other professional activities since the 9th Academic Council meeting across various departments.

The members emphasized the need to increase the number of research papers published by faculty members in order to improve institutional performance in rankings such as NIRF. They further suggested that faculty members may be provided with financial support and encouragement for publishing quality research papers. It was also suggested that research publications and related academic contributions may be considered as part of the faculty self-appraisal process. The members also suggested promoting start-up activities by facilitating access to dedicated incubation and innovation facilities.

The Chairman appreciated the suggestions made by the members, agreed with the recommendations, and thanked the Council members for their valuable inputs and constructive suggestions.
