1. Create / Log in to CMT Account

- Go to the CMT submission link provided by the conference
- Sign in using:
 - Microsoft account (Outlook, Hotmail, etc.)
- If new:
 - Click **“Register”**
 - Verify email

👉 Mistake people make:

- Using multiple emails — later they can't track submission
- Not verifying email — submission fails silently

Step 5: Upload Your Manuscript

- Drag and drop or upload your main paper file.
- **Format:** The file is usually expected to be a PDF. It must strictly follow the Springer formatting guidelines and stay under the 10 MB file size limit.
- **Double-Blind Policy:** ICDISF-2026 uses a double-blind peer-review process. You **must remove all author names and affiliations** from the document before uploading.
- **⚠ Common Mistakes:** Uploading a Word document instead of a PDF, or accidentally leaving author names inside the blind submission file

Step 6: Submit and Verify

- Once everything is filled out and uploaded, click the **"Submit"** button at the bottom of the page.
- You will know your submission was successful when the system generates a specific **Submission ID** for your paper. If you do not see an ID, your paper was not submitted properly.

Step 7: Declare Conflicts of Interest (COI)

- Immediately after hitting submit, CMT will redirect you to the "Edit Conflicts of Interest" screen.
- To ensure a fair and ethical peer-review process, you must declare if you have a conflict of interest with any potential reviewers or committee members (e.g., people from your own university, recent co-authors, or close colleagues).
- If you have a conflict, search for their name and click "Edit" to mark it. If you have no conflicts, you can safely return to your Author Console.
