# **Covid19: Safe Management Measures**

#### Please note all these measures are **MANDATORY**

- Wear your mask at all times in the office apart from during Tea / Coffee breaks and meal times.
- 2. Record your temperature and sanitise your hands at the main gate BEFORE entering the college, all temperatures equal to or above 100 F (or) 37.5 C will not be allowed to enter.
- 3. Sanitise your hands regularly throughout the day.
- Download and activate your Aarogya Setu App for the duration of your office Day.
- 5. Use Safe Entry to check IN and check OUT of the office.
- Continue to Work from Home if you have a strong reason Not to attend the Office.
- 7. Record your temperature again in the afternoon.
- 8. Sit at alternate work places / separate work stations to increase distance between them.
- Lunch to be eaten at respective sitting places to discourage gatherings.
- 10. Do not share food, utensils or any other personal items.
- 11. Dispose off all used and unwanted masks and tissues immediately.
- 12. Do not hold external meetings in the office; all meetings to be conducted online only.
- 13. Do not hold events / activities / celebrations in the office.
- 14. DO NOT travel to the work place if you are presenting any symptoms, even if Minor
- 15. Do not socialize with staff members outside the department / work place.

### **Guidelines for use of mask**

The correct procedure of wearing triple layer surgical mask

- 1. Perform hand hygiene.
- 2. Unfold the pleats; make sure that they are facing down.
- 3. Place over nose, mouth and chin.
- 4. Fit flexible nose piece over nose bridge.
- 5. Secure with tie strings (upper string to be tied on top of head above the ears lower string at the back of the neck).
- 6. Ensure there are no gaps on either side of the mask, adjust to fit.
- 7. Do not let the mask hanging from the neck.
- 8. Change the mask after six hours or as soon as they become wet.
- 9. Disposable masks are never to be reused and should be disposed off.
- 10. While removing the mask great care must be taken not to touch the potentially infected outer surface of the mask.
- 11. To remove mask first until the string below and then the string above and handle the mask using the upper strings.
- 12. **Disposal of used masks**: Used mask should be considered as potentially infected medical waste. Discard the mask in a closed bin immediately after use.
