# Agenda Item No.1:

To Confirm the Minutes of the 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council held on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

#### Minutes:

Prof. G. ChandraMohan Reddy, the Principal and Chairman of the Academic Council informed that the minutes were circulated to all the members and briefly presented the minutes of the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council (AC) held on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 to the esteemed members and the same were confirmed by the members.

### Agenda Item No.2:

Ratification of Almanac of I and II semesters of B.Tech, I and II semesters of M.Tech and Revised Almanac of VII and VIII semesters of B.Tech for the Academic year 2024-25

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 2 regarding the approval of the almanac for the B.Tech I and II Semesters, as well as for the M.Tech I and II Semesters. Additionally, the revised almanac for the VII and VIII Semesters of B.Tech for the academic year 2024-25 was presented and the same is attached as Annexure-I.

After presenting it, the Principal submitted for the approval and the same was confirmed by the members.

#### Agenda Item No.3:

Result Analysis of B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held during July/August 2024

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 3 regarding the result analysis of the B.Tech and M.Tech Semester End Examinations held in July/August 2024. To improve the results, corrective measures were suggested, including conducting remedial classes after analyzing the performance of students in the first midterm exams. However, irrespective of the quality of student intake, the respective Heads of Departments and faculty members are informed to identify and adopt innovative teaching methods to further enhance the results.

Dr. Praveen Shankar Jambholkar suggested that the poor performance of first-year students may be due to gaps in their foundational knowledge from their intermediate studies. He proposed that these gaps could be addressed by identifying students who are weak in mathematics and physics. This can be effectively achieved through the application of AI to pinpoint individual foundational gaps. By providing targeted subject enrichment classes, students will be better equipped to enhance their knowledge and perform better in their first year. Ultimately, improving subject skills will lead to better academic results.

### Agenda Item No.5:

Ratification of inclusion of two open electives (one in 6<sup>th</sup> Semester and other in 7th Semester) and professional electives in the curriculum of ECE in MR-22 Regulations as per MoU with Indian Railways Institute of Signal Engineering & Telecommunications (IRISET).

Minutes: The Chairman presented Item No. 5 regarding the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Railways Institute of Signal Engineering and Telecommunications (IRISET) for the introduction of courses on Railway Signaling and Automatic Train Protection System(KAVACH)as suggested by AICTE. At MGIT the same is being planned to implement as professional electives for ECE students in VI and VII semesters and open electives for other branch students in VI and VII semesters. The syllabus for these subjects has been approved by the respective Boards of Studies (BoS) and the same is enclosed in Annexure IV.
