The IQAC meeting was held under the chairmanship of the Principal. The members reviewed and deliberated upon the agenda items. The following resolutions were made:

Item No. 1: Approval of Minutes of the Previous IQAC Meeting

The minutes of the IQAC meeting held on **30.12.2025** were presented before the members. The Action Taken Report (ATR) on the resolutions passed in the previous meeting was reviewed and discussed.

Resolution:

The minutes of the previous IQAC meeting and the Action Taken Report were approved by the members.

Item No. 2: Academic Plan of Action for the Academic Year 2026–27

The committee discussed the academic plan and quality initiatives for the academic year 2026–27. Emphasis was placed on strengthening Outcome-Based Education (OBE), student mentoring, remedial classes, internships, project-based learning, value-added courses, certification programs, interdisciplinary learning, placement enhancement, higher education opportunities, and entrepreneurship activities.

Resolution:

1. All departments shall prepare and implement academic calendars and quality improvement plans.
2. Student mentoring and remedial support mechanisms shall be strengthened.
3. Departments are encouraged to certification courses, industry internships and projects for students.
4. Special initiatives shall be undertaken to improve placements, entrepreneurship, and higher education opportunities.

Item No. 3: Review of Academic Audit

The committee reviewed the findings of the Academic and Administrative Audit conducted across departments. Discussions focused on course file maintenance, lesson plan implementation, attainment analysis, student performance, and quality enhancement practices.

Resolution:

1. Departments shall ensure proper maintenance of course files and academic documentation.
2. Effective implementation of lesson plans and continuous monitoring shall be carried out.
3. CO–PO attainment analysis shall be reviewed periodically and corrective actions implemented.
4. Departments shall submit compliance reports on audit observations within the stipulated timelines.
5. Best practices identified during the audit shall be shared across departments and implemented.



Item No. 4: Implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE)

The implementation status of OBE was reviewed. The committee discussed CO–PO mapping, attainment assessments, assessment methods, and continuous improvement processes.

Resolution:

1. All departments shall strengthen CO–PO mapping and attainment processes.
2. Both direct and indirect assessment methods shall be effectively implemented.
3. Academic Gap Analysis shall be conducted by every department.
4. Year-wise documentation of academic records shall be maintained systematically.
5. Recommendations arising from gap analysis shall be forwarded to the respective Boards of Studies (BoS) for curriculum enhancement.
6. Experiential learning, internships, mini-projects, and industry-oriented activities shall be further integrated into the curriculum.

Item No. 5: Innovative Teaching–Learning Practices Implemented

The committee reviewed innovative teaching-learning methodologies adopted by departments, including ICT-enabled teaching, virtual laboratories, simulation tools, flipped classrooms, peer learning, and project-based learning.

Resolution:

1. Departments shall continue to adopt innovative and student-centric teaching methodologies.
2. Faculty members shall be encouraged to utilize digital content, virtual labs, and simulation tools.
3. Students shall be motivated to participate in hackathons, technical competitions, and multidisciplinary projects.
4. Departments shall document and share innovative teaching practices periodically.

Item No. 6: Faculty Development and Research Promotion Activities

The committee reviewed faculty participation in FDPs, workshops, research publications, sponsored projects, patents, consultancy, and collaborative research activities.

Resolution:

1. Faculty members shall be encouraged to participate in FDPs, certification programs, workshops, and conferences.
2. Departments shall promote quality research publications in reputed journals and conferences.
3. Efforts shall be intensified to secure sponsored research projects, consultancy assignments, and patents.
4. Interdisciplinary research in emerging technologies such as AI, ML, IoT, EV Technologies, Renewable Energy Systems, and Smart Technologies shall be encouraged.
5. Collaborative research initiatives with industries and research organizations shall be strengthened.



Item No. 7: Industry Collaborations with Institution

The committee discussed measures to strengthen industry–institution interaction through MoUs, internships, expert lectures, collaborative projects, consultancy, and Centers of Excellence.

Resolution:

1. Departments shall actively pursue MoUs with industries and reputed organizations.
2. Internship and industrial training opportunities for students shall be enhanced.
3. Industry experts shall be invited regularly for technical talks and workshops.
4. Collaborative projects and consultancy activities shall be promoted.
5. Efforts shall be made to establish industry-supported laboratories and Centers of Excellence aligned with the institution's research centers.

Item No. 8: Outreach Activities and Stakeholder Engagement

The committee reviewed NSS activities, community service initiatives, alumni engagement, parent interactions, stakeholder feedback, career guidance, entrepreneurship awareness, and outreach programs.

Resolution:

1. Departments shall continue to organize extension and outreach activities for societal benefit.
2. Alumni engagement activities shall be strengthened through regular interactions and mentoring programs.
3. Stakeholder feedback shall be collected, analyzed, and utilized for continuous improvement.
4. Career guidance and entrepreneurship awareness programs shall be organized periodically.
5. Students shall be encouraged to participate in national-level technical, cultural, and social outreach programs.

Item No. 9: Any Other Item with the Permission of the Chair

The committee discussed the introduction of Minor Degree Programmes by various departments to enhance interdisciplinary learning, technical specialization, employability, and adaptability to emerging technologies for the academic year 2025-26 admitted batch.

Resolution:

1. The members appreciated the initiative of introducing the following Minor Degree Programmes after the approval of JNTUH.

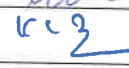
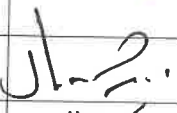
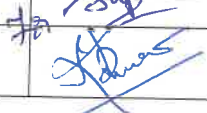

3. The implementation and outcomes of the programmes shall be periodically reviewed to ensure effectiveness and alignment with industry requirements.

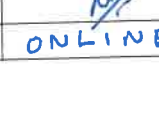
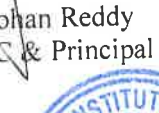
Conclusion
